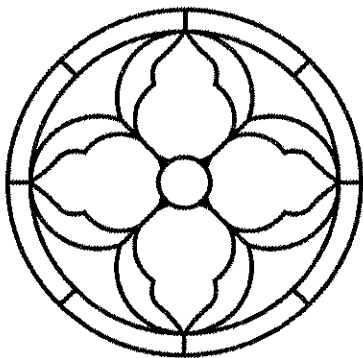
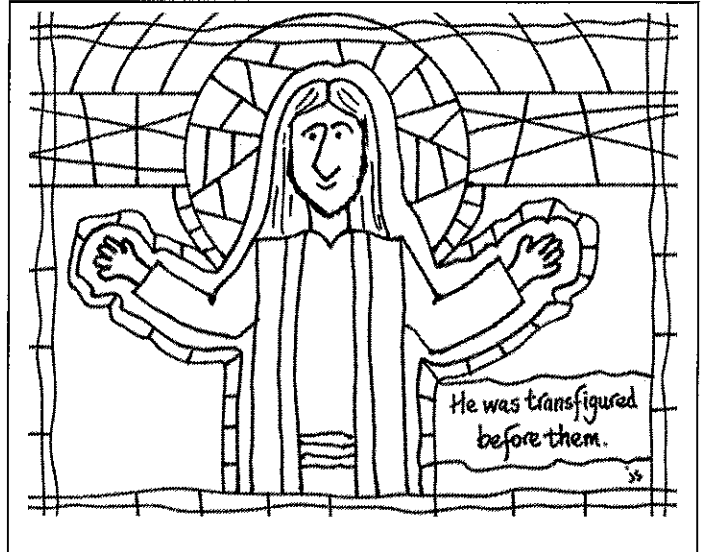

Great News! We will be returning to in-person worship services this week beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022.

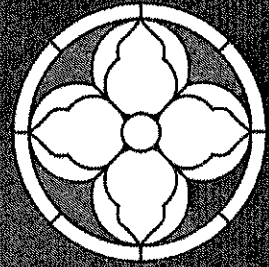
